Off-Campus Robbery

(SPD #2009-443905)

WEDNESDAY - 9/9/2009 - 10:25 PM- 100 Block Judson Street

Two SUNY College of Environmental Science and Forestry students walking on the 100 block of Judson Street in the East Neighborhood at 10:25 p.m. Wednesday were approached by two suspects who stole property while brandishing a firearm. The description of these suspects and the weapon utilized is similar to the description of the two suspects in a robbery that occurred on Monday, Sept. 7, on the 100 Block of Smith Lane in the outer Comstock area (a map depicting the location of both robberies can be found by accessing campus alerts at <http://publicsafety.syr.edu/>).

The victims described the suspects as: Suspect #1 male, black 5'10" tall, unknown age, last seen wearing dark clothing and a hooded sweatshirt, carrying what appeared to be a long barreled handgun. Suspect #2: male, black, 6'0" tall, unknown age, last seen wearing dark clothing and a hooded sweatshirt. § FOR YOUR SAFETY, PLEASE REMEMBER: On campus after dark, use DPS free escort service.

§ Off campus, - remain vigilant- use SU Home (it's free), call 443-2224 for more information about these services.

§ Centro Bus or taxi service.

§ Walk, bike or jog in groups of three or more - away from bushes, cars, and other objects a suspect could hide behind.

§ Look and listen. Headphones and cell phones can create tunnel vision.

§ Travel in well-lighted and well-traveled areas.

§ Don't approach strangers or let them get close to you.

§ If you think someone is following you, switch directions or cross the street. Go toward an open business or lighted house.

§ Have your house or car keys in hand before you reach your door.

§ Know where "Blue Light" phones are and how to use them.

§ If someone tries to rob you, don't resist. Give up your property, not your life.

Try to get a description of the suspect(s) and any associated vehicle & tag number

IMMEDIATELY report emergencies or suspicious activities, persons and vehicles.

For Public Safety dial 711 (on campus) #78 (from a cell phone); for Syracuse Police dial 911.

Your quick report may help prevent others from becoming victims.
